

Poul Volther was born in Copenhagen, Denmark on January 2, 1923 and died on January 23, 2001. He studied design at the Arts and Crafts School in Copenhagen. As a teacher at Denmark's Design School, he encouraged hundreds of students to aim for high quality craftsmanship. From 1949 he was employed by the cooperative [FDB](#) at Hans Wegner's recommendation and working in their the design studio under the leadship of [Børge Mogensen](#). When Mogensen left in 1959, Volther took Mogensen's place. The Corona chair design was born by a desire to economize on materials after WWII.
