Garrard was the Crown Jeweller of the UK, charged with the upkeep of the <u>British Crown Jewels</u>, from 1843 to 2007.

More recently, Garrard has been noted as being the maker of the sapphire engagement ring given by <u>Charles, Prince of Wales</u>, to <u>Diana, Princess of Wales</u> for their 1981 marriage.
