

French Art Deco Six Arm Modernist Chandelier

Description

This 1930's French art deco modernist chandelier has it in "sixes". The bright nickel body hangs from a six sided shaft with six arms emanating from a six sided center, at the outer end of the arms are six sided sockets for the bulbs. The bulbs are above frosted and clear planes each with six sides. Above the center a pyramid of three discs is separated by spacers. The discs and spacers all have six sides. The chandelier, which is 23" in diameter and drops 31 1/2" from the ceiling, has been replated in bright nickel and rewired for American electricity
