Description

Lurelle Guild (1898 - 1986) designed this American art deco wine cooler in 1934 for the Chase Brass & Copper Company. Constructed of chrome plated copper, the cooler has a relief placque designed by Rockwell Kent (1882 - 1971) depicting the child Bacchus (the Greek god of wine) carrying bunches of grapes and flanked by two gazelles. The cooler measures 9 1/2" tall and is 8" in diameter. On each side, a ring handle for carrying. The cooler was only in the 1935, 1936 and 1937 catalogs.
