Norman Bel Geddes (1893 - 1958) designed this American art deco cocktail set in 1936 for Revere Copper and Brass Company. Known as The Manhattan, the chrome plated cocktail shaker, tray and two cups are marked "Revere, Rome, NY". The shaker is 13 " high and 3 ¼" in diameter, the tray is 14 ½" x 11 ½".
