Description

This French art deco vase was designed ca. 1929 by Luc Lanel (1893 - 1965) for Orfeverie Christofle, Paris. The copper vase, with green and black oxidized patina has a band of "arrowhead" decor a flaring rim and a spread foot. It is marked on the base "Chirtofle", "B 187" and "E". The vase is pictured on page 52 of "Lanel, Luc & Marjolaine" by Dominique Forest. The vase is 8 ½" high 5 ¾" diameter (at the rim) and 3 3/8" diameter at the foot.
