A Rosenthal porcelain of a girl riding on the back of a faun by Albert Caasmann (1886-1968) ca. 1920. It is signed on the base "A Caasmann". A partial paper label on the base identifies the piece as "Flucht" (flight) and gives a number "1495". It is marked in green underglaze "Rosenthal Selb-Bavaria" The figure is $5\,\frac{1}{4}$ " tall and is in mint condition.
