

Degue French Art Deco Blue Cameo Glass Vase

Description

This French art deco cameo glass vase was designed by Edouard Cazaux (1889 - 1974) ca. 1930 for "Verrerie d'Art Degue". A shimmering blue translucent glass is acid cut in a geometric pattern to reveal the lower layer of textured and frosted colorless glass. In 1926 David Gueron, who owned "Cristalleries de Compiègne", entered the art glass business and named his business "Verrerie d'Art Degue". In 1928 Cazaux joined him and designed special pieces with strong deco and geometric themes...this is one of those pieces. The 10" high vase is signed in cameo "Degue".
