Description

Géorges Conde (1891 - 1980) designed this sleek French art deco white craquelé ceramic panther in 1931. The panther was manufactured by Saint-Clement and retailed at "La Galerie d'Art Moderne Pomone" in Bon Marché, Paris. The panther is signed "Geo Conde" a name he adopted to avoid confusion with another artist of the same name. Standing 10 ½" high and 19" long, the panther is in excellent condition.
