

Donald Deskey For Amodec American Art Deco Bedroom Set Reference:

MPD-001710 Description

Donald Deskey (1894-1989) designed this bedroom set in 1931 for AMODEC (American Modern Decoration), a company he founded. The line was produced for him by the Thomasville Chair Company and the Finch Furniture Company, both of Thomasville, North Carolina. Constructed of natural finished figured primavera veneers and mahogany stained maple trim. The set consists of a headboard, two nightstands and a four drawer chest. The chest , which measures $35 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide, $18 \frac{1}{4}$ " deep and $45 \frac{1}{2}$ " high is stenciled on the back "AMODEC line 13, No 927-10 chest", a metal "AMODEC" tag is in the top drawer of the chest. The two nightstands are $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide, 18" deep and $27 \frac{1}{4}$ " high, one stand has a metal "AMODEC" tag. The headboard is stenciled on the back "AMODEC line 13, No 927-6 bed and is 57" wide and 36" high.
