The rarest and considered the most beautiful of the 1925 Paris Exposition posters. This vintage poster was created by Emile-Antoine Bourdelle (1861 - 1929). Bourdelle was a highly regarded sculptor, painter and illustrator. Upon his death in 1929 Anatol France called him "The most famous Frenchman of his time". the stone lithograph captures the delicate colors of Bourdelle's composition including the elusive violet.
