This rare table features gorgeous polished nickel faceplates to the rounded feet along with dual polished nickel crosspieces that pierce through the respective table base ends to be visible.

This table has been carefully hand stripped and refinished to an exceptional mirror-like high gloss using Deco-Dence's trademark Italian polyester finish that is totally water and alcohol impervious and extremely resilient to bumps, bruises and scratches.
